### How to Apply

1. Review our grant guidelines to determine eligibility
2. Submit grant application based on guidelines provided (must include a copy of IRS tax-exempt determination letter and most recently filed Form 990)

*R.A.C.E. Mission: R.A.C.E., racing advocates for community enrichment, was established in 2012 providing support to nonprofit organizations and charitable causes while volunteering to cultivate community growth. A Chicagoland Speedway and Route 66 Raceway foundation, R.A.C.E. aims to improve the quality of life for the greater Chicagoland area. We are a 501-c3 non-profit entity under the umbrella of the NASCAR Foundation.*

*The NASCAR Foundation embodies the compassion of the NASCAR Family and our commitment to serving communities. The Foundation seeks to raise funds and increase volunteerism to support non-profit charities and charitable causes throughout the nation with an emphasis placed on initiatives that affect the ability of children to live, learn and play.*

**Since 2006, The NASCAR Foundation has helped provide medical treatment for more than 20,000 children visiting Speediatrics annually, fulfilled more than 500 NASCAR Dreams, sent more than 1,000 kids to Victory Junction camp, recruited 15,000 fans to become part of a Volunteer Network and dedicated nearly \$11.5 million in donations and non-profit programming. United by The NASCAR Foundation we are all making a difference.**

The NASCAR Foundation makes grants to 501(c)(3) tax exempt charities in the United States, with a focus on organizations that have a tie to children. The Foundation does not make loans or grants to individuals or endowment funds. Grants will be reviewed on a yearly basis and will typically range from \$500 to \$10,000. (The NASCAR Foundation may authorize grants in excess of \$10,000 at the discretion of its Board of Directors).

The NASCAR Foundation will consider only one proposal from the same organization in a 12-month period and will give first priority to organizations that have been invited to apply for a grant. However, unsolicited requests that match the eligibility requirements will also be considered by the committee. All requests will be reviewed and all applicants will be notified of the grant decisions within 2-4 weeks of submittal. Due to an anticipated high volume of requests, not all applications will be approved for funding.

Please review the following eligibility questions before beginning the application process. If you do not meet the eligibility requirements but still submit an application, The NASCAR Foundation reserves the right to not review or respond to your application for funding.

To be eligible you should be able to answer “Yes” to the following three questions:

1. Is your organization an IRS qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization?
2. Is your program located in the United States?
3. Is your organization non-discriminatory in policies and practices with regard to physical abilities, gender, race, sexual orientation, ethnic origin and/or creed?

To be eligible you should be able to answer “No” to the following three questions:

1. Are you seeking support for an individual person or family?
2. Are you seeking support for a political candidate or organization?
3. Are you seeking funding for religious activities, in whole or part, for the purpose of promoting religious doctrine?

If you were able to answer the above questions in the appropriate way, please continue with the application process. Please answer the questions from the attached Grant Proposal Form to the best of your ability.
